

The University Scholars Program allows students to apply up to 12 hours of graduate coursework toward both the undergraduate and master's degrees. To be eligible students must have 1) completed a minimum of 90 hours 2) senior standing 3) completed all University Studies requirements and 4) a GPA of 3.50 or better in their major and an overall GPA of at least 3.20. University Scholars are classified as undergraduates until they have completed the number of credit hours required for their undergraduate degree. Undergraduate tuition rates will be applied to the graduate level coursework designated for dual credit. **This completed form must be uploaded to a Graduate School application (<http://www.research.uky.edu/gs/ProspectiveStudents/Admission.html>) which must be submitted in the students junior year.** In most cases the GRE is not required for admission to the University Scholars Program.
